



Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

The Olentangy Education Foundation was established as a nonprofit corporation in 1990 to enhance the academic programs of the Olentangy Local School District. Through community investment, college scholarships are awarded to deserving graduates, and creative education programs are granted to enhance public school programs that tax dollars cannot support. Additionally, the Foundation has established an Endowment Fund to support Olentangy Schools in the future. This year, the Foundation will award two \$1,500 scholarships to deserving seniors at each Olentangy High School.

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible students must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA and must be a senior in good standing at either Olentangy High School. They must enroll in an institution of higher learning in the 2010-11 school year. Primary criteria used to select recipients will include academic achievement, written expression, school and community activities and interpersonal skills.

AWARD:

The selected recipients will each receive a \$1500 scholarship for the first year of study at an institution of higher education anywhere in the United States. This award is **to be used for tuition expenses only, made payable directly to the recipient's institution of higher learning** and is not renewable. The scholarship may be forfeited if the recipient does not attend an institution of higher learning in the 2010-11 school year.

APPLICANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Olentangy Scholarship application must be typed or printed in ink
- Permission to Publish form must be included with application
- High school transcript must be included with application
- Deadline for applications is 3:00 p.m. on April 1, 2010
- Applications must be submitted to the Olentangy, Olentangy Liberty, or Olentangy Orange High School Student Services office
- Finalists will be required to have a personal interview with OEF Scholarship Committee:
 - OLHS: April 19, 2010
 - OHS: April 20, 2010
 - OOHS: April 21, 2010
